Today we will be exploring, the story of Jacob wrestling with God and getting a new name. You can find the story in your Bible in Genesis chapter 32 verse 22–32 & chapter 35 verse 1–15

Story of Jacob wrestling with God



In today's Bible lesson, Jacob spent an entire night wrestling with an angel of God. When Jacob as alone, a man wrestled with him until daybreak. Wrestling is fighting and overpowering another person by holding them down. When the man saw that he cannot overpower Jacob, he touched the socket of his hip and it was dislocated.

Though Jacob is now limping, he did not let the man go. So the man said, "Let me go for it is daybreak." Jacob answered, "I will not let you go unless you bless me." The man asked, "What is your name?" He said, "Jacob." The man then said, "Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel, because you have struggled with God and with men and have overcome."

Jacob called that place "Peniel" because he saw God face to face and yet lived to tell about it. As he went to be with his family, he walked limping.

After an entire night of wrestling, God's angel told Jacob to walk away. Jacob left the wrestling match with a new name and a limp from his hurt hip. We sometimes struggle with God, too. We may want to do things our way instead of His way.

Ice cube challenge



Put ice cubes in a bowl and set your family a challenge to see who can be the quickest to melt an ice cube. They can use a straw to blow hot air on it, sprinkle salt on it, or hold it to try to melt it most quickly. Give kids one minute to try to melt their ice cube using their chosen method. Meanwhile, turn on the hair dryer and blow hot air on your ice cube. Call time, then compare everyone's efforts. How did your way compare to my way of melting the ice cube? We can surrender to God's will and trust that He knows best.
