Read and reflect on Ephesians 4:17-32. Use any of the following questions to help you as a group to get to grips with what this passage means for your group today:

- What are your initial reactions to this passage?
 - Is there anything you don't understand?
 - What verse or verses jump out at you?
- What does this passage tell us about:
 - God?
 - Humanity/us?
- What do you find the hardest thing to do in the passage?
- 4:25 – How honest are you with friends, family, other church members?
- 4:26 – Are you good at resolving conflict or do you try to avoid it?
- 4:29 has two parts: which do you find easiest?
 - When was the last time someone said something encouraging to you?
 - How did it make you feel?

What could you practically do to change at work, with friends and family, and in church off the back of this passage?

What one thing do you need God to help you to change after today?

How can you keep each other accountable for these things when you next meet?
